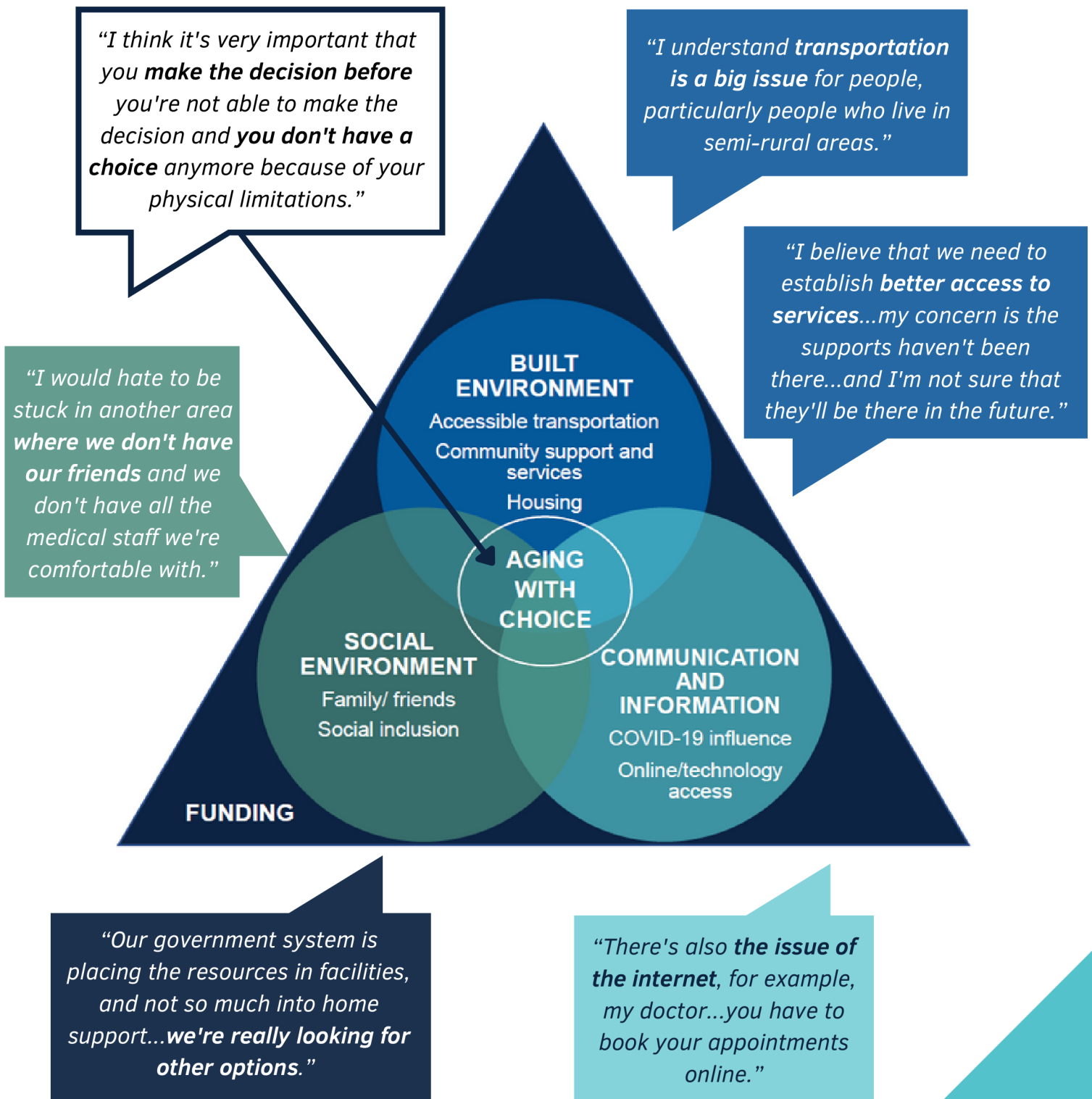

# Thematic Analysis

This figure shows the major themes that emerged in our study. *Ageing with choice* was central to each theme and connected across all themes. Optimal choices become possible only when the built environment and the social environment are supportive of ageing in place and when information on how to access those supports is readily available. All of these are influenced by the underlying funding landscape.
